Subject : Sporting rules

Dear Board Members,
Dear Members of the Sporting Technical Commission,

For a few years, the evolution of our sporting discipline has let arise new problems, to which we must imperatively answer, so that we can approach the season 2008 under the best conditions.

Among the raised problems, we must face:

- a drift of the behaviour of some shooters;
- a drift in the layout of the courses,
- a dispute or an almost systematic questioning of the decisions of the referees;
- Inaccuracies or lacks in the rules.

For that it is necessary for us:

- to redefine what is the Sporting discipline and thus to specify our rules;
- to specify the missions, the rights of referees;
- To specify the rights and the duties of the shooters;
- To update the sanctions to be applied against shooters not abiding by our rules.

For all these reasons, I propose you some very important modifications in the form and the spirit of our rules, which will have to be operational for the beginning of the 2008 season.
