



PROCEDURES FOR THE CARRIAGE OF FIREARMS THROUGH SINGAPORE

The Singapore Air Navigation Orders requires that all passengers traveling **to, from or through Singapore** apply for a permit with the Singapore Airport Authorities to carry their firearms and ammunition.

Requirements for the Carriage of Firearms

An application form must be completed and submitted with the following documentation;

- End user certificate i.e. Firearms licence,
- Copy of the import/Export certificate form Arms & Explosives (form attached)
- Commercial invoice of firearms to be carried (this applies only to newly purchased firearms).

Note: Applications submitted must, include full details of the firearms, and ammunition (if applicable), failure to do so will result in the application not being processed.

Permit Fee:

SGD 45.00 (one time payment each consignment, and includes return flight),
(This fee includes multiple passengers, travelling in the one group under the same booking reference, provided the inbound and outbound flights are the same)

Security Escort Fee:

SGD 136.00 (per journey, does not include the return flight),
(This fee includes multiple passengers, traveling in the one group under the same booking reference, provided the inbound and outbound flights are the same)
